1. Oldershaw - Heavenly Blonde(3.8) - Blonde session ale, grapefruit & Passionfruit aroma, crisp, dry & refreshing
2. Oldershaw - Posh Return(4.3) - Specially brewed for PBBF 11, vary pale & aromatic bitter, Citrus infused delight
3. Oldershaw - Grantas Gold(4.5) - Specially brewed for GBF 11, Golden, tangerine citrus aroma, dry & floral, hugely refreshing
4. Oldershaw - Venus Rouge(4.2) - 2nd brew from 'Project Venus' (Lady brewers get together). Amber bitter, reddis, aromatic grapefruit & floral balanced by malt
5. Dark Tribe - Harmstock 8 (3.8) - No tasting notes
6. Dark Tribe – Starfish Delight (4.1) - New beer from Judy's seasonal specials
7. Brewsters - Calamity jane(4.8) - Latest 'Wicked Woman' amber, zesty & tropical
8. Springhead - Roaring Meg (5.5) - Golden with a citrus hoppy aroma & a dry finish
9. Springhead - Maid Marion Blonde (4.5) - A pale, golden beer with a fruity orange aroma & dry finish

Yorkshire

10. Kelham Island - Vincent Black Lightening (4.8) - Hand crafted continental style black beer
11. Abbeydale - Dr Morton's Goat Flush (4.5) - Pale beer with subtle spicy orange & clove flavours, well rounded finish

Hertfordshire

12. Buntingford - Sladek (4.0) - Golden single hopped with Czech Sladek hops
13. Buntingford - August(4.2) - Blonde summer ale

14. Dancing Duck - Nice weather for Ducks (4.1) - Copper coloured summer ale
15. Dancing Duck - Gold (4.7) - Modern IPA, powerful hoppy bitterness and aroma with malt
16. Muirhouse - Shunters Pole (3.8) - Pale, refreshing & hoppy with Columbus & Styrian hops
17. Muirhouse - Pirates Gold (4.5) - Golden summer beer packed with admiral hops

18. Concrete Cow - Pail Ale (3.7) - Very pale, refreshing and zesty
19. Concrete Cow - Cock N Bull Story (4.1) - Traditional style bitter, amber with balanced malts & hops

20. Copthorne - Classic (3.8) - Crisp golden brew with a hint of honey
21. Copthorne - Comanchie (4.0) - Copper beer with caramel overtones
22. Mallard - Hearty Goodfeathers (3.9) - Golden session ale, house ale for the Hearty Goodfellows at Southwell
23. Mallard - Quackerjack (4.0) - Copper coloured fruity beer
24. Prior's Well - Silver Chalice (4.1) - Very pale, citrusy beer, with dry hoppy finish
25. Prior's Well - Father Hawkins (4.5) - Deep red/brown best bitter
26. Welbeck Abbey - Ernest George (4.2) - Deep brown ale, packed with chocolate, roast malts & black barley, balanced with english hops
